## CONGRESSMEN PETERSON AND LINDER TO INTRODUCE HISTORIC FAIRTAX LEGISLATION AT CAPITOL HILL NEWS CONFERENCE

**WHAT:** Congressman Collin Peterson (D-Minn.) and Congressman John Linder (R-Ga.) will conduct a Capitol Hill news conference to introduce the historic FairTax bill.

**WHY:** The FairTax, a proposal developed by Americans for Fair Taxation, is a national sales tax that would replace all federal income and payroll taxes - and would eliminate the Internal Revenue Service. It would allow every wage earner to collect his/her FULL PAYCHECK every pay day.
